Terms & Conditions: Eligibility & Admission Criteria

- Required Eligibility:** Students who have passed 4-year B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. (Hons.) in the relevant subject/discipline with minimum 160 credits and required CGPA of 6.5 or equivalent percentage of marks as prescribed by the concerned Department.
- Entry Point:** Such eligible students shall be admitted directly to the 3rd Semester of the respective 2-Year PG Programme or 9th semester of the respective 5-year Integrated Programme to complete the remaining two semesters for the award of a postgraduate degree.
- Duration:** The PG Degree for such students will be of one-year duration comprising 2-Semesters and a minimum 40 credits with PG Dissertation.
- Equivalence & Credit Transfer:** Admission will be subject to mapping/equivalence of courses to be ensured by the concerned Departmental Admission Committee. Credits earned by the candidates during UG shall be evaluated and considered by the committee directly or through Academic Bank of Credits [ABC]. However, as per the requirement of the respective programme, the students shall enroll to the particular Non-CGPA courses recommended by the Departmental Committee.
- Lateral Entry:** This provision is a lateral-entry option under the 'Multiple-Entry Multiple-Exit' scheme of NEP-2020, allowing admission for students directly into the second year of a PG programme.
- Intake:** The intake in each programme shall be 06 seats.
- Admission Criteria:** The admission shall be based on the merit of the candidates in the qualifying exams (4-year B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. (Hons.) in the relevant subject/discipline. However, preference shall be given to candidates who have appeared in CUET-2026 conducted by the NTA.
- Other Norms:** All other eligibility conditions, reservation policy and admission procedure of the University shall remain applicable.
